## Hunt County Shared Ministries -- FISH Community Garden Contract for Gardeners 2015

## **Guidelines and Rules:**

- 1. The FISH Community Garden will provide the garden plot and access to water.
- 2. There is an annual fee of \$15.00 for each plot. Gardeners will be allowed to adopt up to two (2) plots. If a gardener wishes to have more than two plots, he/she must seek approval from the FISH Executive Director or the Community Garden Committee.
- 3. The lease period is from January 1 through December 31. Gardeners should notify FISH by December 1 of their intention to either return or leave the Fish Community Garden for the next year.
- 4. If a plot must be abandoned for any reason, the gardener must notify FISH at 903 455-0545 or via e-mail wjeffers@hcsmfish.org.
- 5. There is no refund of the annual fee.
- 6. Gardeners will be <u>responsible for the planting and weed-free maintenance of their</u> <u>allotted plot and adjacent paths and to keep it in VEGETABLE AND FRUIT production</u> <u>during the growing season.</u>
- 7. If a garden plot becomes unkempt, is not maintained or is neglected, the responsible gardener will be contacted by the FISH Garden Committee. Abandoned or neglected garden plots are eligible for reassignment.
- 8. Gardeners will work only in their own assigned plot unless they have permission from another plot user.
- 9. Ripe fruit and vegetables will be harvested on a regular basis (as needed) by the gardener. Gardeners are encouraged to donate surplus fruit and vegetables to the FISH Food Pantry.
- 10. Watering of the garden is the gardener's responsibility
  - a. Watering is permitted 7 days a week, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (except during Jan Feb watering is only available Monday Friday 9 a.m. till Noon upon request)
  - b. No overhead watering
  - c. No unattended watering
- 11. Supervised children are welcome.
- 12. Pets are not allowed in the gardens.
- 13. Gardeners will be encouraged to use organic gardening methods. Gardeners should not use fertilizers, insecticides or weed repellents that will in any way affect other plots.
- 14. Invasive (spreading) plants should be contained.
